<u>Spring, 2021 Newsletter</u>

As most of you know, last year in 2020 we were not able to hold our Annual Meeting for The Methodist Cemetery Association at our usual Tenleytown location, or at the usual time of year, due to the Corona Virus pandemic. However, we did conduct the Annual Meeting in September virtually, via Zoom. The Zoom meeting was very well attended, and everyone appeared to enjoy this virtual format.

At the Annual Meeting last year, it was announced that the 2021 meeting was to be held on May 2, 2021. However, we recently notified you that we are now planning on having the Annual Meeting on Sunday, September 12, 2021 at 2:00 p.m. This meeting will again be held virtually via Zoom. This is a very convenient format which allows you to participate in the business of the Association in the comfort of your home. Any members who do not wish to appear on video, can still participate, although it would be nice for everyone to introduce themselves to the group. However, if possible, we may also be able to host a group at the cemetery along with the Zoom participants. We will keep you posted on this possibility.

For those of you who do not have computer access, a telephone contact number will be provided which will allow you to phone in so you can hear the meeting on your regular telephone. Or, you may want to consider asking for help from a friend or relative who has a computer or Smartphone and can use Zoom - which is a free application for the user.

Tree Maintenance:

We ended 2020 with tree maintenance in the snow. In mid-December we had to have a very large branch cut out of the huge white oak tree in the middle of the cemetery. It had broken and was caught up in the lower branches, just dangling. This was an emergency due to the possible danger to anyone walking or working below as well as to nearby tombstones. We had all other existing dead-wood trimmed out of the tree at the same time.

Tombstone Repairs:

I'm sure you will remember that we were supposed to have some tombstone repairs by the *Mosko Monument Services*, a company that specializes in cemetery conservation, preservation, and restoration. While their work in our cemetery has been delayed (by many factors, not the least of which was a stop-work order due to the pandemic), they are now attempting to schedule our work for this spring.

Our webmaster, Steve Shoemaker, is doing a great job. The relationships included on the *Burials* page are almost complete - as to what is known. However, Diane Tamayo keeps "running into" more unmarked burials and more information, and has been preparing another bunch of updates, so stand-by (patiently!).

We are also interested in adding a "Members Only" menu item which among other things will provide Association members' contact information. This will be helpful to members doing ancestral research as well as provide the ability to contact each other. More information will be provided on this website addition at the Annual Meeting.
