

The Methodist Cemetery is the final resting place for several families with the surname Burrows. My great-grandfather, Robert Henry Burrows (1854-1933) was a son of Proverb Burrows (1825-1901) and Mary Emmeline Queen (1836-1918). "Bob" Burrows was a building contractor, and belonged to the William R. Singleton Lodge No. 30 of the Masons in D.C. Pictured with him in the photo are his wife, Hattie Powers Burrows (1866-1931), daughter-in-law (my grandmother) Kitty Lowry Burrows, along with her two eldest children, Sue (1918-2014) and my mother Barbara Mary (1920-1991). It is believed that Robert Burrows' parents and grandparents are also buried at The Methodist Cemetery.
